GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION:

State submerged lands along the shore on the southwestern portion of Big Lake.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

SW1/4 NE1/4 Section 36, Township 17 North, Range 4 West, Seward Meridian

REQUESTED ACTIVITY: Applicant, Alaska Sailing Club, Inc., is requesting a land use permit for continued use of seasonal floating docks and ramps, as well as 10 mooring buoys. The dock and ramp structures in state-owned submerged land include:

- Floating docks consisting of sections as follows:
 - one 8 feet by 180 feet shoreline dock
 - one 8 feet by 100 feet extension dock
 - one 3 feet by 20 feet "finger" dock
 - two 3 feet by 16 feet "finger" docks
 - one 3 feet by 8 feet "finger" dock
 - one 8 feet by 12 feet "small boat launch" dock
- Access ramps consisting of:
 - one 8 feet by 16 feet ramp
 - one 4 feet by 14 feet ramp
 - one 3 feet by 16 feet ramp

PROPOSED DATES OF USE:

Start: May 1, 2023

End: April 30, 2028

DEADLINE FOR COMMENTS: June 13, 2023

The public is invited to comment on this activity. The purpose of this notice is to gather input

before a decision is made on this activity. To ensure consideration, written comments must be received by the Division of Mining, Land and Water at the Southcentral Regional Land Office, 550 W. 7th Ave., Suite 900C, Anchorage, AK 99501-3577 on or before 5:00 PM on the date noted above.
